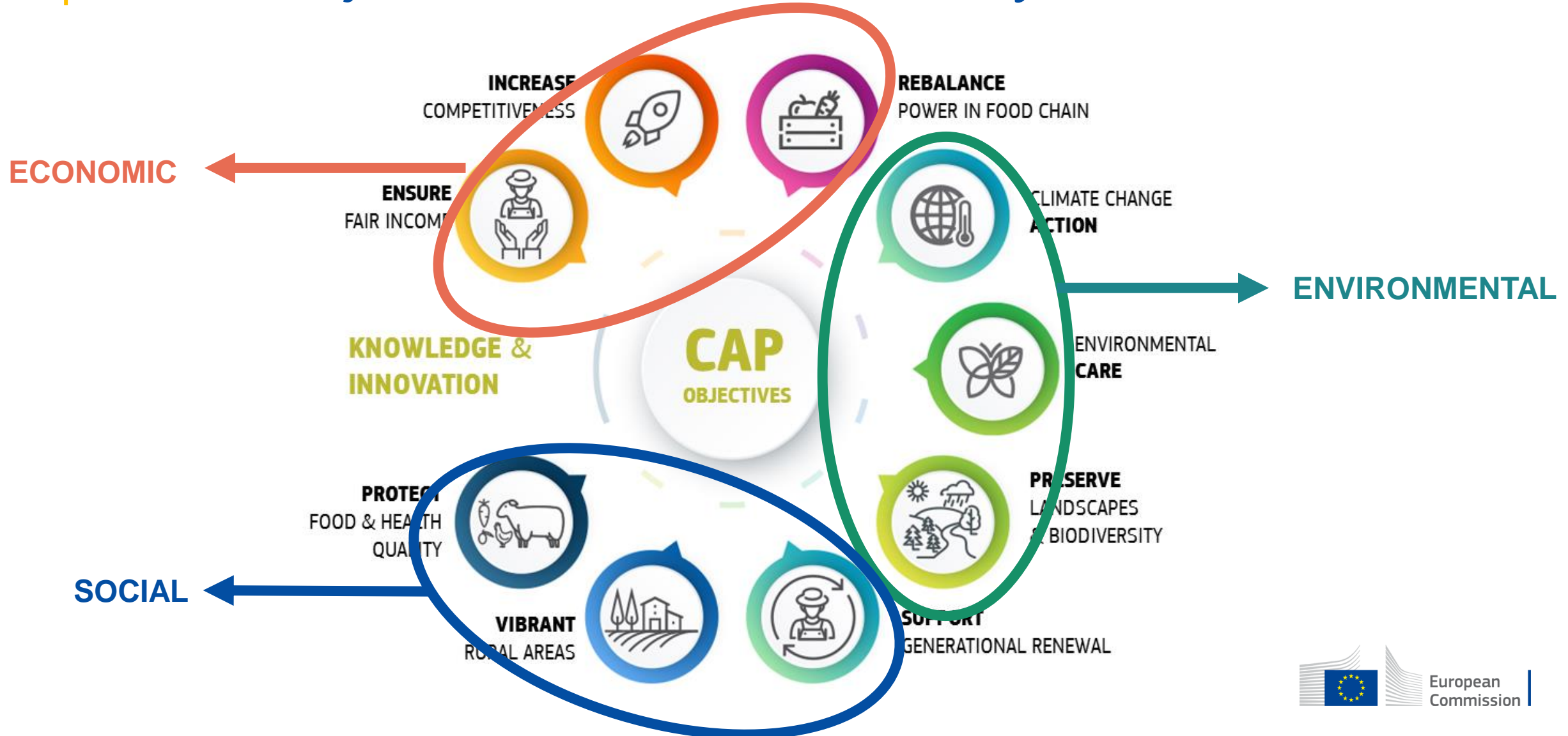




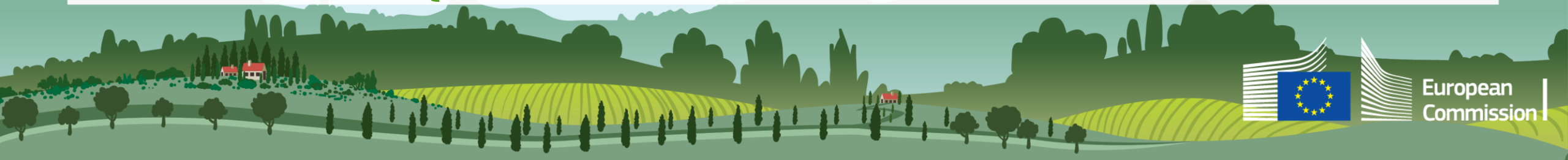
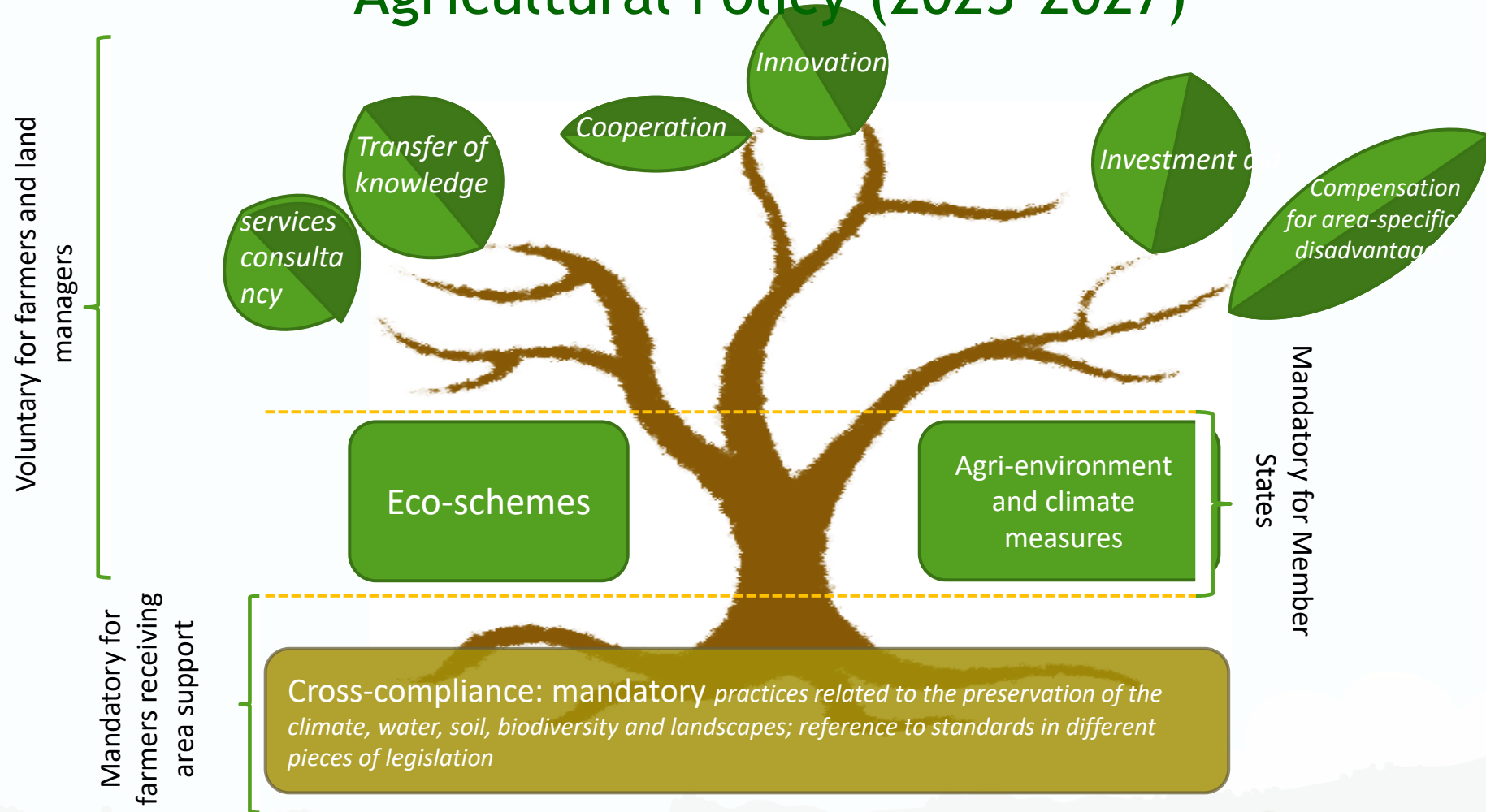

# Key elements of the “green architecture” of the Common Agricultural Policy (2023-2027)



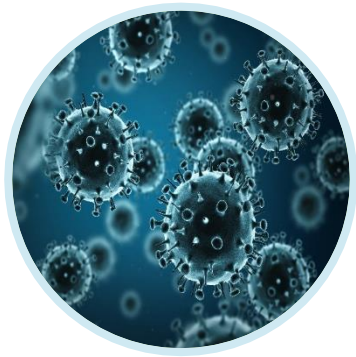
# The Green Deal Targets (F2F and Biodiversity Strategies)



Reduction by 50 % of the overall use and risk of **chemical pesticides** and reduction use by 50 % of more hazardous **pesticides** by 2030



Achieve at least 25 % of the EU's agricultural land under **organic farming** and a significant increase in **organic aquaculture** by 2030



Reduce sales of **antimicrobials** for farmed animals and in aquaculture by 50% by 2030



Reduce **nutrient losses** by at least 50 % while ensuring no deterioration in soil fertility; This will reduce use of **fertilizers** by at least 20 % by 2030



At least 10 % of agricultural area **under high-diversity landscape features** by 2030



Achieve 100 % access to **fast broadband internet** in rural areas by 2025

# Green Deal alignment

**Three mechanisms to align the CAP Strategic plans to the ambition foreseen in the Green Deal:**

- Assessment of the CAP Strategic Plans
- Alignment to changes of the climate and environmental legislation
  - Compulsory assessment and eventual modification of the CAP Strategic Plans
- Reporting mechanisms by the Commission:
  - In 2023: to assess the joint efforts of all the CAP Plans in a collective way
  - In 2025: Commission report with possibility to issue recommendations to the MS
